



## Massena Local Waterfront Revitalization Program (LWRP) Waterfront Advisory Committee Meeting #6 DRAFT Meeting Summary Notes

This was the sixth meeting of the Village of Massena LWRP Waterfront Advisory Committee (WAC). The meeting was attended via Zoom by members of the Committee and consultants.

The purpose of this meeting was to go through any process update as well as any local updates. A slideshow accompanied this meeting and is available separately for review.

### 1. Introductions & Committee Business

Bob Murphy started the meeting by giving a brief summary of the last Committee Meeting (held in October 2021) – the meeting summary was discussed and approved. Mr. Murphy will finalize this and Ms. Chatland will post online. Mr. Hardy was introduced as a new member of the Committee.

### 2. Timeline

The next step is to advance the Proposed Project Concepts. Public Workshop #2 will be held in person (late August or September 2022). A Preliminary Plan will be completed in October, and a Community Open House will be held in January or February of 2023.

### 3. Local Updates – DRI

Relevant updates happening in the Waterfront Revitalization Area (WRA) include DRI projects, which are:

- A river walk from Veterans Park to Water Street



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- A wooden playground/splashpad in Danforth Park

#### 4. Completed Sections

Mr. Murphy went over the drafts of Sections 1-4. The DOS has reviewed Sections 1-3, and Section 4 is to be submitted to the DOS after further development.

B&L and A&C plan to more fully develop the concept and estimates including Project Profiles. Feedback on the proposed Projects and Top 5 Priorities is needed. Mr. Murphy will send out this prompt.

#### 5. Proposed Land & Water Uses

Mr. Murphy discussed the proposed land and water uses shown in the draft of Section 4. These include (using Nicandri Nature Center as an example):

- A campsite north of Grasse River property as potential purchaser
- A flower garden, gazebo/pavilion, and small stage with electrical in Water Street Park
- A dog park/beach
- A Kiosk on water quality and environmental
